## Reversible Quilt with Sandee Streech

Resource Book: Reversible Quilts, Two at a Time by Sharon Pederson

Fabric needed: Finished quilt: 58" x 77"

NOTE: yardage listed is for one side of quilt you will need to purchase enough fabric for both sides of the quilt.

• Side #1 and #2:

These should each be different/contrasting combinations to make your quilt exciting.

2 yards solid (not pieced) triangle fabric, or equivalent of scrap

2 yards of assorted fabrics for strips

• Sashing

11/8 yards fabric for 1 3/4" sashing on side #1

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard fabric for 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" sashing on side #2

- Binding 5/8 yard fabric for 2 1/2" wide cut strips
- Batting 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards of 96" wide batting

## **Bring to class:**

- ➤ Basic sewing kit including pins, needles, scissors, seam ripper, pencil
- Rotary cutter, rulers and mat
- Sewing machine in good working order with a new needle, power cord and foot pedal

## **Pre-class preparation:**

- \* From Batting: Cut 48 10" squares
- \* Large triangles: Cut 24 squares 10 3/8" square and cut again on the diagonal and create 48 triangles for each side
- \* Strip Fabrics: Cut three different width from fabrics for each side. Cut these strips random, roughly measuring each strip

Wide =  $2'' - 2^{1/2}$ "

Medium =  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " -  $1 \frac{3}{4}$ "

Narrow =  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " -  $1\frac{3}{8}$ "

\* Sashing

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard piece into 1 ½" wide strips for side #1

1½ yard piece into 1¾" wide strips for side #2

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.
