Pattern: Rising Star Pattern by Cozy Quilts

Fabric/Supplies needed: (for twin size quilt)

- 16 quarter yard cuts or 46 - 2½” strips (a little more than a jelly roll)
- 4¼ yards background fabric
- 1¾ yards border fabric
- 5½ yards backing fabric
- ¾ yard binding fabric
- 4½” square ruler or larger for trimming
- 12½” square ruler or larger for trimming
- Add-a-quarter ruler (very helpful)
- 18” or longer rotary ruler
- 4½” square or larger of template material
- Mechanical pencil (marking wrong side of background fabric)
- Highlighter

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper & water soluble marking pen
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, ruler and mat for use with rotary cutting

Pre Class Preparation:

- Cut three 2½” strips from each colored fabric. If using a jelly roll, eliminate any that will fade into the background and supplement from stash to reach 46 total strips
- From your background for twin (see pattern for other sizes) cut the following:
 - 8 - 4½” strips, which are then cut into 60 - 4½” squares
 - 14 - 2½” strips
 - 6 - 8” strips, which are then cut into 30 - 8” squares

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
- ◆ One week cancellation notice required to refund or credit fees. No refunds for visiting teachers.
- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).

- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label all your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Pre Class Preparation:

- Select pattern size using the finished garment measurement listed on the pattern envelope. To do this, hold a tape measure around the fullest part of your bust and then let the tape out to correlate to the finished bust measurements on pattern. This will give you a better idea of the design drape and fit of the pattern.
- Wash, dry and press fabric
- Trace pattern pieces for your size onto freezer paper making sure to transfer all markings
- You can cut your fabric at home, but please leave all pattern pieces together with the cut fabric and be sure you have transferred all marking to the fabric

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
