Required Pattern: Camelback Carry All by Janine Babich Designs

Bring to each class:

- Sewing machine in good working order with foot control, power cord, its accessories and a new needle or reserve a machine for rental at Bernina Connection. Allow 15 minutes to get rental set up.
- You should be familiar with your machine prior to class.
- Bring your sewing machine instruction manual
- Basic sewing supplies to include: fabric marking pen, seam gauge, pins, fabric scissors, and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter, 6½" x 24" ruler and cutting mat
- Thread to match chosen fabrics
- Iron and ironing pad (optional but helpful)

Fabric needed:

- Use only 100% cotton woven material/fabric for the following lessons. We will discuss the next project scheduled at each class. Please feel free to ask questions prior to class.

- **June 10: Camelback Carry All**

Camelback Carry All Pattern

2 fat quarters of coordinating fabric (outer fabric and lining fabric)-Fat Quarter size is 18" x 22"

Coordinating/contrasting thread

½ yard of medium-weight fusible fleece

14" nylon coil zipper in color that coordinates with fabric

6" piece of ½" or ¾" wide grosgrain or satin ribbon in a coordinating color

½ yard ShirTailor fusible interfacing

Wonder tape

OR

- **Tech Case**

⅓ yard or 1 fat quarter exterior fabric

⅓ yard or 1 fat quarter lining fabric

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

Tech Case continued

¼ yard or 1 fat quarter for pocket
½ yard fusible fleece
1 yard fusible interfacing (ShapeFlex)
⅝" or 1" button
Button hole foot
Fabric marking pen

- **June 17: Lounge pants or boxer shorts**

Purchase pattern **Kwik Sew Pattern K3345**
1 yard of 1" wide elastic
Purchase fabric based on your size on the back of the Kwik Sew Pattern
Sewing thread to match fabric

- **July 8: Pleated Purse**

1½ yard exterior fabric
½ yard lining fabric
1 fat quarter or ¼ yard pocket fabric
4 yards woven fusible interfacing (ShapeFlex)
2 - 1½" x 1½" fusible fleece
¾" magnetic snap
9" all purpose polyester zipper
Zipper presser foot
Fabric marking pen

OR

- **Carry All Clutch:**

¼ yard or 1 fat quarter for exterior
¼ yard or 1 fat quarter for lining
¼ yard fusible fleece
½ yard Décor Bond fusible interfacing
4" of ¾" wide sew in Velcro
1" D-ring or 1" swivel latch
9" all purpose polyester zipper

- **July 15: Reversible placemats**

1 yard main fabric
1½ yards backing fabric
¾ yard binding fabric
1 yard batting
Painter's tape
Walking foot (optional)
Fabric marking pen
