Fabric/Supplies needed:

- Walking foot (dual action systems acceptable)
- Free motion foot (also called darning foot or embroidery foot) **YOU MUST HAVE ONE OF THESE FOR CLASS**
- New sewing machine needles, size 80/12 (Microtex sharps work well)
- 100% cotton Aurifil thread, ecru or off white
- 100% cotton Aurifil thread, darker colored cotton, (blue, red, brown, black) in a bobbin
- Invisible nylon (or monofilament) or clear polyester thread, .004 mm thickness (YLI, Sew Art, Wonder, Sulky, Superior and Madera are good brands)
- Three 16” pre-washed muslin squares
- Three 18” pre-washed muslin squares
- Three 18” batting squares (Try to bring a variety of brands if you have them. Otherwise you may try to trade with other students in class) Please write down the brands of the batting you bring
- Blue wash out marking pen (not a PURPLE pen)
- Masking tape (1” or 1½” wide is sufficient)
- 18” or 24” ruler
- Approximately 50 safety pins (size #1 or #2)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle. Bring owners manual for your sewing machine (know how to eliminate feed dog action, adjust thread tension, etc.)
- Walking foot (dual action systems acceptable)
- Basic sewing kit to include: scissors, extension cord, paper and pencil, several empty bobbins

Pre Class Preparation:

- Prepare your fabrics prior to class see page 2
