Tea Towel Apron *with Lynn Pfaff*

Tuition: \$25.00

Pattern: None

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- One tea towel (size 20" x 27")
- 9 - 2½" strips cut the width of fabric (great way to use up left over pre-cut strips)
- 24" see thru ruler
- Thread to match color of apron for the bobbin and sewing the casing
- Thread that will blend with colors of strip fabric
- Ruffler foot #86, edge stitch foot #10, 10C or 10D, ¼" patchwork foot #97D or 37D (optional)

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: pins, machine needles, scissors, seam ripper, removable marking pencil, seam gauge
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool, and ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- Pre-wash and dry and press your tea towel (this will prevent any distortion when you wash and dry after using your apron)

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.
