The Cube Tote with Diane Mathus-Nagano

Pattern: The Cube by Penny Sturges (pattern includes the metal frame)

Fabric/Supplies needed:

- Fat quarter for outer bag and outer pocket
- Fat quarter for inner bag and outer pocket lining
- Fat quarter for handles and inner bag bottom cover
- yard fusible fleece (45" wide)
- > ½ yard single-sided fusible foam (58" wide)
- yard Peltex single or double-sided fusible stabilizer (20" wide)
- Clover Wonder Clips
- Chalk marker
- Fabric Fusion glue or Clear Gel glue (optional)
- ≥ 24" zipper to coordinate with fabric
- Presser feet: #10 topstitch, #57 or other 1/4" foot, #4 zipper foot
- Walking foot (optional)
- ➤ 80/12 or 90/14 needles
- Coordinating thread
- ➤ Point turner/Presser tool
- Frixion or other disappearing fabric marking tool

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler **Pre Class Preparation:**
 - Press fabrics with Best Press spray
 - Cut pattern pieces from fabrics and fusibles
 - Organize your pieces using labels included in pattern. This is essential!

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Pre Class Preparation:

- Press fabric with Best Press spray
- Cut pattern pieces from fabrics and fusibles and LABEL them.
- > Use fusible fleece for the zipper tabs, not foam
- You can cut the bag handles a little longer if desired (22" 23")
- Keep your pieces labeled!
- Outer Bag End Pocket Stabilizer piece—cut foam or fleece 5.5" x 4"
- Quilt the inner bag and outer bag main pieces. may want to cut them an inch larger all the way around, then trim after quilting. Hint: it is easier to quilt all the way across on those pieces.
- The measurements of all the pocket pieces may not make sense—don't worry! They can be a bit confusing, so you can quilt those in class.
- > Keep your pieces labeled!
- These steps are essential to making progress in class!
