Pattern: **A.** Tool Tote, **B.** The Boxy Tote or **C.** The Cube by Penny Sturges
(all patterns include metal frame)

Fabric/Supplies needed: Tool Tote

- **A.** ½ yard for outer end pockets, handle, outer bag front and back
- **B.** 1 yard for outer and inner bag ends, outer bag front and back pockets, inner bag front and back
- **C.** ¾ yard for inner end pockets, inner front and back pockets, outer bag end pocket linings, outer back and back pocket linings
- ½ yard fusible fleece (45" wide)
- ½ yard single-sided fusible foam (58" wide)
- ⅓ yard Peltex single or double sided fusible stabilizer (20" wide)

Fabric/Supplies needed: The Boxy Tote

- 1 yard for outer end pockets, handle, outer bag front and back
- 1 ⅓ yards for outer and inner bag ends, outer bag front and back pockets, inner bag front and back
- 1 yard for inner end pockets, inner front and back pockets, outer bag end pocket linings, outer back front and back pocket linings
- ½ yard fusible fleece (45" wide)
- 1 yard single-sided fusible foam (58" wide)
- ⅓ yard Peltex single or double sided fusible stabilizer (20" wide)

Fabric/Supplies needed: The Cube

- **A.** Fat quarter for outer bag, outer pocket
- **B.** Fat quarter for inner bag, outer pocket lining
- **C.** Fat quarter (can be same as A) for handles and inner bag bottom cover
- ⅓ yard fusible fleece (45" wide)
- ⅓ yard single-sided fusible foam (58" wide)
- ⅓ yard Peltex single or double sided fusible stabilizer (20" wide)

By the Way: It is important to have all your materials before class begins and have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time and we want you to get full benefit of the class experience.



- ◆ Classes must be paid for at time of registration.

- ◆ Materials list is provided at time of registration. All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome in our classes (except Machine Mastery).
- ◆ As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- ◆ No kids in adult classes; no adults in kids classes.
- ◆ Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
- ◆ You may bring your lunch (we have a refrigerator) or we will take lunch orders for a local restaurant at your expense.
- ◆ We do our best to make everyone happy but we're all on different "thermostats". You may want to consider bringing clothing layers which you can put on or take off to keep comfortable.
- ◆ Label your equipment (rulers, scissors) to avoid mix ups.

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Fabric/Supplies needed: For all sizes

- Wonder clips
- Chalk marker
- Fabric Fusion glue or Clear gel glue
- 24" separating zipper to match fabric
- Presser feet: #10, #57 or other ¼" foot and #4 zipper foot
- Walking foot (optional)
- 80/12 or 90/14 needles
- Coordinating thread
- Point turner/presser tool
- Disappearing fabric marking tool
- Teflon pressing sheet

Bring to class:

- Sewing machine with power cord and foot control, cleaned and in good working order with a new needle
- Basic sewing kit to include: fabric marking pen or pencil, ruler, scissors for clipping threads, shears, pins and seam ripper
- Rotary cutter with a good blade, mat for use with rotary cutting tool and ruler

Pre Class Preparation:

- Cut pattern pieces from fabrics and fusibles
- Organize pieces using labels included in pattern (this is essential to making progress in class)

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
