

Supply List Colorblock Tote

Description: Create a modern, functional tote using the Colorblock Tote pattern by Robin Pickens. This tote's clean lines and bold blocks make it an excellent project for exploring color placement while building your bag-making skills.

Skill Level: Confident Beginner

Supplies Needed:

- Colorblock Tote pattern by Robin Pickens
- White marking pen
- Wonder Clips
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade (45mm or 60mm)
- Cutting ruler (recommend 6in x 18in or similar)
- Thread in a neutral or coordinating color
- Sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal
- **Highly recommended:** Walking foot for sewing machine

Fabric Requirements:

- Fabric A for main exterior body – 2/3 yard
- Fabric B for main interior and stripes – 3/4 yard
- Fabric C for handles, pocket, and stripes – 3/4 yard
- Fabric D for handles and stripes – 1/4 yard
- Fabric E for stripes – 1/8 yard
- Fabric F for stripes – 1/8 yard
- Foam stabilizer - 1 1/2 yards (we used byAnnie's Soft and Stable)
- Fusible fleece – 1/4 yard

Don't forget these basic notions!

- Extra bobbins and sewing machine needles
- Small cutting mat (recommend 12in x 18in)
- Fabric marking pens/pencils
- Straight pins
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Best Press or spray starch
