Quilt Making for Beginners

Description: If you're new to quilting or have always wanted to make a quilt but aren't sure where to start, this is for you! You'll leave this class with a finished quilt top and the confidence to start another!

Skill Level: Beginner

Bring all fabrics and supplies to the first class. If you purchased an item but aren't sure it's the right one, don't open it yet! We'll go through the list to be sure everyone is equipped and ready!



Required Supplies:

- Jacob's Ladder quilt pattern by Fabric Café (included with registration—They'll be available at the first class.)
- Quilting ruler 6" x 24" long (or similar size)
- Square quilting ruler at least 8.5" x 8.5" with a 45-degree line
- Rotary Cutter (45mm or 60mm) with fresh blade
- Seam Ripper
- Thread in a neutral or coordinating color
- Scissors
- Straight pins
- Marking pen/pencil that will show up on your fabrics
- Sewing machine/power cord/foot pedal. If you don't have one that travels well, give us a call as soon as possible. We have a limited number available for rent.
- **OPTIONAL:** ¼" presser foot for your sewing machine
- **OPTIONAL:** Small cutting mat (12in x 18in or similar)
- **OPTIONAL:** Best Press or spray starch

Fabric Requirements:

- Quilt Top: 1 yard each of 3 different fabrics. We recommend one light, one dark, and one focal print.
- Binding: ½ yard of one of the above fabrics or another that coordinates well

We have ready-made fabric bundles that work well with the pattern OR choose your own! If you'd like help picking fabrics or any other supplies, our staff is happy to help!
